Turkish President Erdogan said he has provided recordings of the **alleged** murder of Saudi (1) _____ in self-imposed **exile**, Jamal Khashoggi, at the Saudi consulate in Istanbul to Saudi Arabia, Britain, France, Germany, and the United States, the Washington Post reported on Saturday.

Khashoggi, a frequent (2) _____ of Saudi Arabia's ruling **monarchy** and the kingdom's de facto leader Crown Prince Mohammed bin Salman, went missing in October 2018 after entering the facility to secure (3) _____ for an upcoming marriage.
