Dear Parents/Guardians, Teachers, Staff and Students,

Re: Arrangement of Special Vacation in 2021 – 22 School Year

In view of the latest situation with the pandemic, the Education Bureau has announced that schools should adjust the summer vacation arrangement in the current school year by bringing forward the holidays from July and August to March and April. The relevant details of the arrangement are elaborated as follows:

1. Important dates to note:

- (a) The last school day before the start of the special vacation will be 10th March, 2022 (Thursday, Day 8).
- (b) The first day of the resumption of normal lessons after the special vacation will be 25th April, 2022 (Monday, Day 1).
- (c) The last school day of the current school year will be 12th August, 2022 (Friday).
- 2. Arrangements during the special vacation:
 - (a) The government has confirmed that our school premises will be used as a centre to run the scheme of "Timely Mandatory Citywide Testing". The public will be entering our school to take the tests as mandated by the government.
 - (b) The school will NOT be open. Unless otherwise specified, teachers, non-teaching staff and students CANNOT return to school during this period of time. There will be no self-study areas for students. No on-site IT technical support will be provided at school.
 - (c) Face-to-face supplementary lessons and activities are not allowed. Teachers may hold online supplementary lessons and activities.
 - (d) S4 and S5 supplementary lessons:
 - (i) The school will centralize the arrangements of the dates of supplementary lessons (i.e. Lesson 1: 9:00 am 9:45 am, Lesson 2: 10:00 am 10:45 am, Lesson 3: 11:00 am 11:45 am and Lesson 4: 12:00 noon 12:45 pm on weekdays and Saturdays, except for public holidays).
 - (ii) Students should attend the supplementary lessons on time.
 - (iii) Students should use the afternoons to complete assignments, revise what they have learned, or as a time to relax.
 - (iv) A supplementary lesson may suddenly be cancelled in case the date concerned clashes with the schedule that the teacher or students need to attend the tests under the "Timely Mandatory Citywide Testing" scheme. The teacher should inform students about the cancellation/changes of the lesson arrangements himself/herself.
 - (v) Based on the information provided by teachers, the school will send messages through eClass App to notify the parents/guardians of the absentees within 1.5 working days after a supplementary lesson concerned.
 - (vi) It is optional for S5 students who wish to withdraw from subject(s) in April or May, 2022 to attend the supplementary lessons subject to the agreement between the subject teachers and the students concerned. Please read point 9 for more details.
 - (vii) The school will send the timetables of the supplementary lessons to all parents and students concerned through eClass App and eClass email on or before 10th March, 2022.
 - (e) Teachers may arrange online supplementary lessons for S1 S3 and S6 students. Students concerned will be notified by the subject teachers individually.

- 3. The Term Test will be cancelled. Amended weighting of assessment for the second term is shown below:
 - (a) Term Test (0% instead of 15%)
 - (b) HW Mark (15% instead of 10%)
 - (c) Final Exam (50% instead of 40%)
- 4. Starting from 25th April, 2022, half-day schooling will be conducted on online channels until further notice. The summer timetable will not be adopted.
- 5. The campus will be reserved as an examination centre for the 2022 HKDSE. Teachers will take turns to invigilate at the public examinations and may not be able to attend some of the normal lessons from 25th April, 2022. In case of the absence of a teacher in an online lesson, students concerned will be notified by the teacher through the Google Classroom in advance. Students will not need to attend the online lessons affected.
- 6. S1 students still need to attend the PET lessons from 25th April, 2022.
- 7. The cycle-day arrangements on or before 5th June, 2022 remain unchanged. For the cycle-day arrangements on or after 6th June, 2022, please read the appendix for more details.
- 8. S4 (2022 2023) Elective Selection:
 - (a) The deadline of the submission of form through S3 Class Teachers to the school will remain unchanged, i.e. 30th May, 2022. The exact method of submission of form (i.e. hardcopy/softcopy) will be confirmed subject to the mode of schooling in May 2022.
 - (b) The results will be announced on our school web page on or before 16th August, 2022.
- 9. S5 students are allowed to submit parent's letters to withdraw from elective subjects, Mathematics Module 1 and Mathematics Module 2 between 25th April and 5th May, 2022 inclusive. In any event, each S5 student should take at least 2 elective subjects apart from the 4 core subjects. An Applied Learning course is regarded as an elective subject. The school will prepare a separate circular to announce the details on or before mid-April, 2022.
- 10. All subject affairs will be announced on the Google Classrooms. Students should ensure that they have joined <u>ALL</u> the Google Classrooms of the subjects that they are studying.
- 11. Students should prior consult their subject teachers for the proper ways to submit assignments through online channels.
- 12. Students should submit all online work and hard copies of their assignments to teachers on time. If assignments are submitted late, students will face the risk of a mark penalty or penalties.
- 13. In case of the cancellation or change of the arrangements of the Final Examination due to the pandemic, the HW mark in Semester 2 will solely be expanded or used as the formation of the total scores of the 2nd Semester.
- 14. Students with unsatisfactory annual academic results will be asked to repeat at the same level in the next school year subject to the number of places available at particular levels.
- 15. In case of needing to deal with affairs related to absence on an activity day or online lesson(s) on a school day, all applications should be sent to leave@stlouis.edu.hk.
- 16. The school arrangements may need to be fine-tuned suddenly subject to the latest announcements from the government or Education Bureau. You are kindly requested to check the eClass email, school web page, school Facebook page, eClass App and Google Classrooms for ad hoc announcements made by the school or teachers on a daily basis.
