Dear Parents/Guardians,

Re: Sports Days 2023-24

1. The School Sports Days will be held on **Monday, 8th January, 2024 and 15th January, 2024** from 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. at Wan Chai Sports Ground, 20 Tonnochy Road, Wan Chai, Hong Kong.
2. The Guest of Honour for the occasion will be Mr. CHAN Cheuk Kit, an eSports representative of Hong Kong for this event in the 19th Asian Games. All should stand to welcome Mr. Chan upon his arrival.
3. Parents and students have to assess their physical abilities before joining as it is a strenuous activity not suitable for students suffering from chronic illness or diseases, and that participation in the competition is voluntary.
4. Students may wear appropriate sport outfit such as school uniform, house jerseys or P.E. uniform. House jackets are also allowed. Only plain sports trousers and shorts in dark colors are permitted. Sandals and jeans are not allowed. Students will be allowed to wear plain jackets in dark colours if the Cold Weather Warning is in force.
5. Helpers and workers (students and staff) with duties in the morning session should report for duties by **8:15 a.m.** on both days.
6. All students, competitors included, should arrive at the venue no later than **8:20 a.m.**
7. All students should bring their student I.D. cards and report their attendance to the prefects at the entrance of the Sports Ground three times on the sports day: upon arrival in the morning, return after lunch break, dismissal.
8. Soft drinks and light snacks may be bought during the opening hours. All should co-operate with the prefects, whose responsibilities are to regulate the number of students seeking access to the tuck shop and to maintain order and discipline, a reflection of a true St. Louis boy. While the guest arrives on the second day, access to the tuck shop will not be permitted. Students should remain at their seats.
9. Any use of mobile phone, cards and boardgame would be prohibited. Chess playing, book reading and revisions are permitted.
10. For security concern, all old boys and parents have to sign in at the venue entrance.
11. Students who wish to take/ have taken leave of absence are reminded to provide a medical proof as it is a school activity day.
12. Your co-operation in complying with the above instructions is earnestly requested so that all may enjoy the occasion.
