Dear Parents/Guardians,

Re: Visiting Art Exhibition as a Part of S1/S2 Visual Arts Assessment

In order to encourage students to participate actively in arts-related activities in the community, S1 and S2 students are required to visit one art exhibition during the academic year. Students should complete an exhibition report after the visit, which carries 15% of the total grade for the Visual Arts subject. Guidelines on report writing will be provided to students during Visual Arts lessons.

In summary, S1/S2 Visual Arts assessment includes the following components:
