International English Language Testing System, IELTS, has been accepted as a widely recognized English Language Test for students who require to use English Language for communication in their local or overseas study. S5 and S6 Students who once took the IELTS would have a chance to assess their English proficiency level and plan for their study prior to the HKDSE. HKEAA has also once published a research on the correlation of HKDSE English Language and IELTS in 2012.

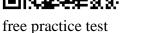
