Re: St. Louis School Badminton Team Practice 2025-26

We are pleased to inform you that your son has been selected as a member of the school badminton team. He will have the opportunity to represent St. Louis School in the upcoming inter-school badminton competitions, provided he continues to demonstrate strong skills, physical aptitude, and good discipline throughout the school year.

Here are the details of the team training:

Time: 4 p.m. – 6 p.m. (Every Tuesday and Thursday)

Venue: To be confirmed (Priority for booking training venues will be given to LCSD sports centres located in the Western and Southern Districts.)

Fee: \$1000

(Funds collected will be used to cover the costs of shuttlecocks, coach salary, and court rental.)

Remarks: Students should arrive at the sports centre 5 minutes earlier for warm-up and they will dismiss at the sports centre after the training.

Temporary scheduled training days are listed below. Please note that training sessions will be suspended during school special events, holidays, and examination weeks.

To foster teamwork and a sense of responsibility, students must inform the teacher advisor or team coach **at least one day in advance** if they are unable to attend training. Absence without proper notification may result in disqualification from competitions or dismissal from the team. Team members who exhibit outstanding performance and/or excellent attendance will be awarded a Light Merit or Minor Merit at the end of the term.
