Re: Sabah Geography Expedition 2026

To help geography students develop a holistic understanding of different geographical features in the world, the Geography Department will organize an overseas geography expedition to Sabah, Malaysia. This expedition will focus on investigating local wetland ecology, tropical rainforests, agricultural activities, and the local culture. The expedition provides opportunities for students to experience the natural environment outside the classroom and to apply their textbook knowledge to real-life situations. Visiting Sabah, an area with incredible natural diversity, featuring tropical rainforests and abundant wildlife, helps to broaden their horizon and raise their interest in geographical studies.
