Remarks:	Payment & Subsidies: 1. Camp fees are non-refundable and will be collected through E-class. ** Eligible students can apply for the Student Activities Support Grant. Required Gear & Clothing: 2. Daily Wear: Please help your child prepare comfortable sportswear, a water bottle, a towel, and a change of clothes. Students should change into their sports gear immediately after their last lesson. 3. Footwear & Water Activities: Students will need two pairs of shoes: one dry pair for land activities, and a separate pair of closed-toe shoes or wet shoes that can get wet. For water sports, please pack appropriate swimming attire (swimsuit or swim trunks). 4. Sun & Bug Protection: Please remind your child to bring a hat, sunscreen, umbrella, and insect repellent to stay protected throughout the activity Mobile Phone Policy: 5. Students will be prohibited from using mobile phones during the activity. All phones will be collected and kept securely by the teachers, though students will be permitted to use them to contact parents during designated timeslots. Please note that activities and venues may change depending on weather conditions or other unexpected circumstances.	

Please be reminded that attendance at The Connection Camp is **compulsory for all S1 students**.
